## Arriving by Plane

**Direct to Sunshine Coast...** Jetstar and Virgin Blue fly direct from Melbourne and Sydney to Sunshine Coast Airport. Travel from Sunshine Coast Airport to your hotel is via SunAir Airport Shuttle (<http://www.sunair.com.au/>) or Taxi (Suncoast Cabs 131008).

**Via Brisbane...** Most other areas fly direct to Brisbane Airport. Travel from Brisbane Airport to Sunshine Coast is via SunAir Airport Shuttle (<http://www.sunair.com.au/>) direct to the Sunshine Coast (80min), or car hire and drive (80min). The 'Get Directions' feature on Google Maps (<http://maps.google.com.au/>) provides good instructions for this drive.
